SOCCER SPECIFIC CONSIDERATIONS

Soccer struggles with overcoming homophobia, transphobia, and queerphobia due to deep-rooted cultural attitudes, lack of openly LGBTQ+ figures, and persistent homophobic chants and behaviors among fans and players. Efforts to address these issues require comprehensive educational programs, stronger anti-discrimination policies, and greater support from clubs and governing bodies to foster inclusivity and respect.

SOCCER SPACES

- Thinking about the spaces that are specific to soccer and taking action in those spaces is a direct way to apply allyship principles to your sport. Make sure locker rooms have inclusive
 - signage and policies, think about conditions for athletes (especially youth athletes) to change in during away games, take note of behavior on the pitch, and work off the pitch with
 - local LGBTQ+ organizations to support each other.
