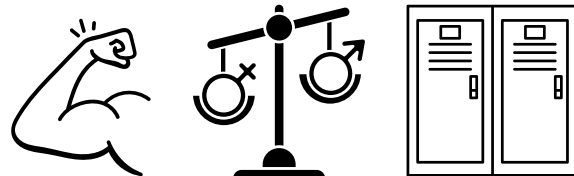


## SPECTATING SPACES

Thinking about the spaces that are specific to the Olympic Games is a direct way to apply allyship principles to your sport. Make sure locker rooms have inclusive signage and policies, think about conditions for athletes in shared spaces like Olympic Villages and locker rooms, be aware of your team’s “locker room talk” and inclusive or exclusive culture, take note of behavior in practice and in competition, and work outside of events with local LGBTQ+ organizations to support each other.
